2. Larry Shinoda chose the name "BOSS", as in the BOSS 302 and BOSS 429, as a homage to his boss Bunkie Knudsen, the former head of Pontiac.

3. The Mustang got bigger in 1971 because Bunkie Knudsen ordered the bigger design in order to fit Ford's beefy 429 ci Cobra Jet V8 under the hood. By the time the '71 was introduced in September of 1970, the muscle car market had collapsed due to increasing insurance rates and increasing emission regulations.

Very few '71's were ordered with the 429 engine.
